



Perceptions About Alcohol and Marijuana Use in Middle School 2021-2022




 50% think none of the students in their grade have drank alcohol in the past month and 59% for marijuana.



High School Alcohol Use by Race and Ethnicity 2021-




This graphs represents the percentages of high school students classified by race and the rates of alcohol use. It is found that **binge drinking** is higher among **white** individuals.

- Hispanic/latino individuals have a 8% higher rate of those that have tried cigarette smoking compared to total high school.
