
INFANT DEATHS

Infant Death is the death occurring to an individual less than 1 year of age.

Infant Death Rate is the number of resident infant deaths divided by the total resident births x 1,000.



This graph represents the number of infant deaths that have occurred in Saginaw County. As seen on the graph, the number **increased** compared to last year. In the span of five years, **90** infant deaths occurred.





This graph represents the average infant death rates in the span of three years based on race. The **moving average rates** of infant death from 2019 to 2021 are:

- 14.5 deaths of Saginaw Black
- 5.8 deaths of Saginaw White

- 13.2 deaths in Saginaw City
- 8.8 deaths in Saginaw County
- 6.5 deaths in Michigan
