

Infant Death is the death occurring to an individual less than 1 year of age.

#### **Infant Death Rate** is

the number of resident infant deaths divided by the total resident births x 1,000.



This graph represents the number of infant deaths that have occurred in Saginaw County. As seen on the graph, the number **increased** compared to last year. In the span of five years, **90** infant deaths occurred.



- 17.3 deaths of Saginaw Black
- 5 deaths of Saginaw White

- 12.2 deaths in Saginaw City
- 8.9 deaths in Saginaw County
- 6.5 deaths in Michigan
